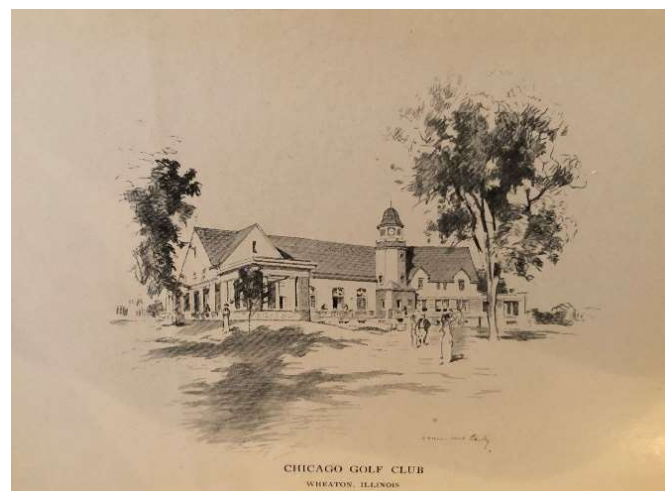
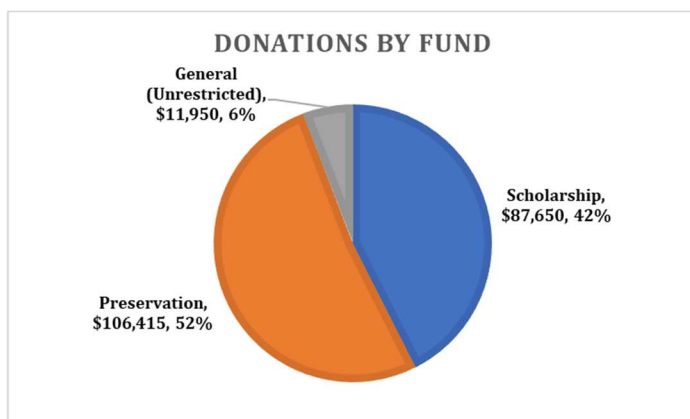
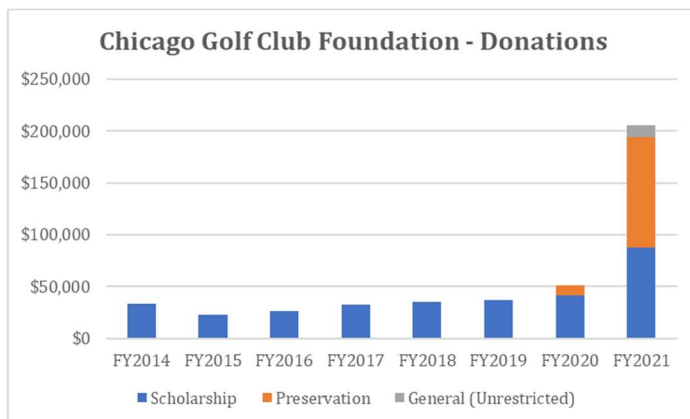
Individual Donors in FY21

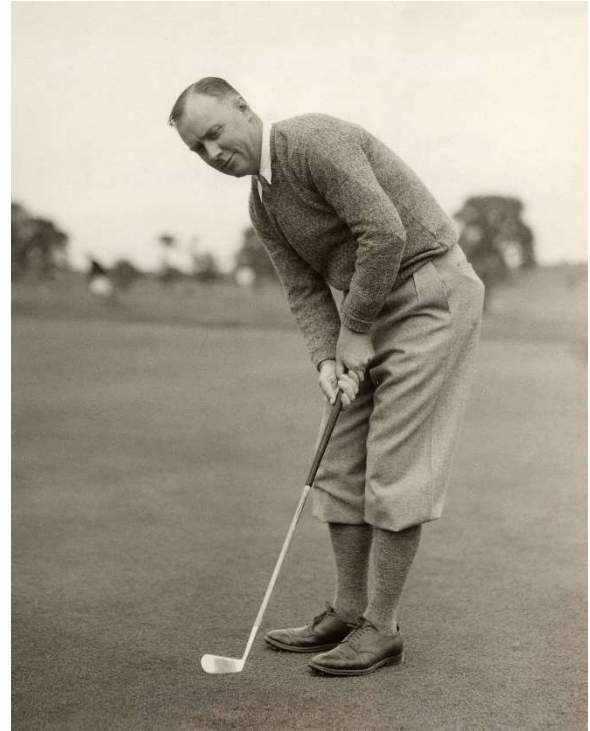

AWARDS – PRESERVATION

The following preservation activities and awards were completed during the 2021 fiscal year:



In association with the new placement on the National Register of Historic Places, the Foundation helped to fund the two plaques now affixed to the clubhouse.



The Evans Scholarship Fund alumni among the membership of Chicago Golf Club generously donated to purchase a putter owned and used by Chick Evans himself during the period when he was a Chicago Golf member (1916-22).



The Foundation has recently awarded \$40,000 to assist with an upcoming study on how to preserve the historic Casino, the only clubhouse structure at Chicago Golf Club to survive the catastrophic 1912 fire.
